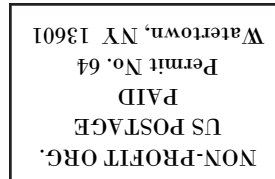

As we enter October it is halfway through my year as Exalted Ruler. I want to thank Bill Ferguson and his crew on a very successful golf tournament.



Thanks to all who have donated their time to the Lodge. The Lodge cannot be successful without your help.


